	Verb	Expresses action, existence, or occurrence	is, are, run, swim, jump
	Adverb	Describes or modifies the verb	quickly, quietly, after, now, here
	Noun	A word that names a person, place, or thing	hen, pond, person, tree
	Pronoun	Is used in place of a noun	he, she, it, they, we, me, you, him, her, them, us
	Adjective	Describes or modifies the noun	red, cold, hot, loud, soft, small, sweet
	Article	Signals the presence of a noun	a, an, the
	Conjunction	It is a joining word. It connects words, phrases, or sentences	and, but, or
	Preposition	Shows the relationship between other words	on, under, behind, around, between, over
	Interjection	A word, phrase, or sound used as an exclamation	wow, boo, hey
